2. FISU Regulations

A. General Terms

- Competitions are held in the following bodyweight categories
 - Men : 55kg, 61kg, 67kg, 73kg, 81kg, 89kg, 96kg, 102kg, 109kg, +109kg
 - Women : 45kg, 49kg, 55kg, 59kg, 64kg, 71kg, 76kg, 81kg, 87kg, +87kg

B. Awards

- Gold, silver and bronze medal is awarded for top lifters in the snatch, the clean & jerk and the total in each category.

3. Fees

A. Obligations of the delegations towards FISU

- FISU registration fee is 20 EUR per person & 40 EUR per person for non FISU members

B. Obligations towards the Organizing Committee

- 70 EUR/night per person / **25% deposit by Monday, July 20.**
 - ※ 140 EUR per night for each additional participant
 - ※ 150 EUR per night for the extra days before Oct. 18th and after Oct. 25th
- Participants must enter the country after sending the participation fee to the OC account after the entry confirmation
- Payment is accepted in Euros only
 - ※ It is not possible to pay by credit card on site. Participants are recommended to pay the full amount before the event for your convenience.

II

Participation

1. Eligibility

- A. A maximum of 25 participants per FISU Member Federation (10 men athletes, 10 women athletes, 5 officials)
- B. Be a citizen of the country he/she represents
- C. Be at least 17 and less than 25 years of age on 31 December 2020
- D. A student who is currently officially registered as proceeding towards a degree or diploma at a university or similar institute whose status is recognized by the appropriate national academic authority of their country
- E. A former student of the institutions who has obtained their academic degree or diploma in the year preceding the event
- F. In accordance with Article 5.6.5 of the IWF Anti-Doping Policy an Athlete who is not listed in the IWF's Registered Testing Pool but wishes to participate in an IWF Event shall provide accurate and complete whereabouts information as set out at Annex I of the International Standard for Testing and Investigations for a period of at least two months prior to the IWF Event in question (by 20 August). An Athlete who does not comply with this provision is not eligible to compete at the IWF Event.

III Transport

1. Official Transport

- A. Official point of entry : Incheon International Airport
 - B. An information guide system will be operated for arrivals at the official point of entry
 - Guide staff will be stationed at Incheon Airport to greet participants and guide them to the main venue
 - Shuttle bus for Airport → Venue → Accommodation
 - Shuttle bus schedules will be determined after the final entry and posted up on the official event website.
 - C. Shuttle bus for arrivals at other airports
 - Shuttles to the venue will be operated from Muan Airport and Gimhae Airport
 - The shuttle bus schedules may differ by airport.
- ※ Transport by train or other means of transport for connection to other airports are not provided

2. Shuttle Bus

- A. Free shuttle bus between Venue ⇔ Accommodation
 - B. Temporary bus stops and timetables installed in venue area
- ※ AD Card is for event shuttle transport only and not for public transport

- B. Support : First-aid by the Gangjin Community Health Center
- C. Placement : Medical staff and ambulance stationed in the competition venue during competition time
- D. Hospital : Gangjin Medical Center
(5 mins. by car, 3km from the competition venue)
- E. Expense cover
 - Injuries that occur during the competition shall be covered by the liability insurance
 - Expense that occur from hospitalization and special medical treatment shall be covered by the patient
